

## On two carnivores from the Pliocene breccia of Weże

The remains of mandibles and teeth of two species: *Felis wenzensis* n. sp. and *Baranogale helbingi* Kormos are discussed. By their characteristic features the species described here come near to the Pleistocene representatives known from some deposits of Europe.
