

Beyrichiacea from the Givetian of the Holy Cross Mts, Poland

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Four new species of the ostracods of the family Beyrichiacea from the marly limestones of the Upper Givetian (= *Stringocephalus burtini* Beds) of the SE part of the Holy Cross Mts have been described and assigned to the genera *Kozłowskiella* (Pribyl), *Reversoscapha* Rozhdestvenskaja, *Welleria* Ulrich & Bassler and *Welleriella* Abushik. The ostracods, trilobites, Crinchostraca and Charophyta are found in the marly limestone intercalations in the stromatoporoid-coral limestone series.

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
