

Fossil Flabellum (Scleractinia) of Antarctica

A new ahermatypic scleractlnian coral, *Flabellum rariseptatum* sp.n., belonging to the *Flabellum thouarsii*-group of species, has been described from Tertiary glacio-marine sequence of the Cape Melville Formation cropping out at the King George Island, South Shetland Islands, Antarctica.
