

## On a new stylophyllid genus, *Pamirophyllum* (Scleractinia, Upper Triassic)

Genus *Pamitophyllum* nov. is known in the upper Norian of the Pamirs and Central Iran, while in the Rhaetian of the Tatra Mountains. Perfectly cerioid colonies with simple intercorallite walls of a septal origin additionally completed

by auxilliary septal spines are characteristic of these corals. A new species, *P. tatricum* Roniewicz, has been described from the Tatra Mts.
