

Remains of Upper Cretaceous Mosaisauridae (Reptilia) of Central Poland

A fragmentary upper jaw with teeth, unattached teeth of the lower jaw from the Maruszów quarry and a single isolated lateral lower tooth from the Nasiłów outcrop have been described, all of them belonging to the Upper Cretaceous (uppermost Maastrichtian) marine carnivorous reptiles of the genus *Mosasaurus* Conybeare, 1822.
