

## Conodonts of the Upper Permian of Poland

Eight species of conodonts, assigned to five genera, are described from the Zechstein limestone horizon of the Werra cyclothem from Wejherowo I.G.-I boring in Pomerania. *Lonchodina vistulensis* n.sp., *Prioniodina lindstroemi* n.sp. and *Hibbardella baltica* n.sp. have been erected as new species. The Zechstein conodonts have been compared with the conodonts being parts of so-called natural assemblages.
