

Lower Cretaceous megaspores from northern Poland

Described are eight megaspore species from the Lower Cretaceous sediments of northern Poland, among them one new combination. The described taxa represent genera: Minerisporites, Arcellites, Hughesisporites, Erlansonisporites, Verrutriletes and Trileites (Triletes). The megaspore wan morphology has been examined in SEM.
