

## Machairodus sp. from the Lower Pliocene bone breccia of Węże (Poland)

First record of *Machairodus* from Poland (locality Węże I) is presented. The material, containing three isolated teeth, presumably comes from the oldest sedimentary cycle of the Węże I breccia (5.5-8.0 My). It is the northernmost known locality of *Machairodus* in Europe.
