

The Middle Oxfordian Perisphinctidae of Zawodzie near Częstochowa (Poland)

Ammonites of the family Perisphinctidae from the Middle Oxfordian of Zawodzie (Częstochowa) have been elaborated. Within the genus *Lithacoceras*, the new subgenus *Subdiscosphinctes* is distinguished. Included in this subgenus are some of the species hitherto assigned to the subgenus *Discosphinctes*; such are: *L.(S.) mindowe* (Siemiradzki) and *L.(S.) kreutzi* (Siemiradzki). Are also described five new species: *Perisphinctes* (*Perisphinctes*) *alatiformis* n.sp., *P.(P.) enayi* n.sp., *P.(P.) multicostatus* n.sp., *P.(P.) swidzinskii* n.sp, and *Lithacoceras* (*Subdiscosphinctes*) *boreale* n.sp. The directions of their migration and their palaeobiogeographical relationships have been elucidated.
