

Additional studies on the Jurassic Trigoniidae of Poland

Eleven trigoniid species of the genera *Trigonia* Bruguiere, *Myophorella* Bayle and *Rutitrigonia* van Hoepen, including one new species, *R. skorkovensis* sp.n., are described from the Jurassic of Poland. The representatives of the genus *Rutitrigonia* are reported for the first time from the Lower Kimmeridgian of Poland which markedly increases the stratigraphic and geographic range of that genus hitherto considered as limited to the Upper Kimmeridgian - Upper Cretaceous of the Philippines, Japan and the southern hemisphere.

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
