

The discovery of Rhabdopleura (Pterobranchia) in the Jurassic of Poland

Fragments of tubarium of *Rhabdopleura kozlowskii* n.sp., etched from calcareous concretions occurring in Callovian clays in Lapiguz clay pit in Luków are described. Comparisons with the species *Rh. vistulae* Kozłowski from Danian of Poland and the Recent *Rh. normani* Allman from Norway have shown that *Rh. kozlowskii* n. sp. more strongly resembles the Recent species.
